2	Choose a future major that you are passionate about.	
3	Please double-check that you choose the correct applicant category.

5	Register online on the official website: <u>admissions.nu.edu.kz.</u>	
6	Remember your username and password. This saves time when you want to log back into the online application form.	
7	Please double check the ID details (IIN, Name, Surname, Father name, birth date, ID details, etc.) mistakes may cause negative impacts on your Application Form.	
8	Check the deadlines for <u>online</u> application. Please note that due to high volume of last minute applications, it is possible that the online system can work slowly on the last day of the deadline. We encourage you to finish your application before the deadline to prevent any issues.	
9	Please be sure that you indicate correct information in your online Personal account. Pay attention to the popping up tips.	
10	Please do not forget to attach JPEG format of your 3*4 photo in your Personal account.	
11	Be sure that all required documents are attached. Check the size and format of the files you intend to upload and ensure they meet the requirement. The PDF/JPEG format is preferred.	
12	Be sure that the Motivation letter is uploaded in PDF/JPEG format. Please mind the limits of the essay.	
13	After filling out the Application form and attaching the required documents do not forget to press the SUBMIT APPLICATION button. Through clicking this button, the applicant cannot independently change the data in the section «My Application Form». To make changes, please contact info_admissions@nu.edu.kz .	
14	Check minimum scores of your SAT /ACT and IELTS/TOEFL. The minimum requirements for these exams are given on the <u>nu.edu.kz.</u> Keep in mind that scores that meet the minimum requirements do not guarantee admission to the NU.	
16	Full details about SAT exams are given on the <u>collegeboard.org</u> website.	
17	If you passed your IELTS examination with a passport, please attach a scan version of the passport. In case you passed the exam with your national ID please attach the scanned national ID.	
18	The graduates of NIS Grade 12 Certificate might choose any Subject, however it is recommended to choose subjects related to your future major.	
19	The graduates of IB DP must choose 3 High-Level subjects.	
20	If you are a Winner of International and/or Republic Olympiads please check the type of your Medal. The list of International and Republican Subject Olympiad are given on nu.edu.kz .	

21	Please be informed that <u>only</u> <u>transfer</u> student category needs to upload the recommendation letter.	
22	Do not forget to send the electronic test results (IELTS, TOEFL, and SAT/ACT) to the Nazarbayev University address via test administrator by using the NU codes indicated on the nu.edu.kz . If you choose the School of Medicine or the School of Mining and Geosciences as your second choice, then you need to attach a second Motivation Letter in English. in your Personal account	
23	Please be informed that applicants who have indicated an additional School as a second choice are considered only by request of the Admissions Committee of the School. This means that your candidacy for participation in the competition for the specialty of the second choice may not be considered.
